All qualified athletes may enter in both individual events in the respective gender. An NOC may enter a maximum of one (1) team in the Mixed Relay event composed of two (2) male and two (2) female athletes and a maximum of one (1) team in the Single Mixed Relay event composed of one (1) male and one (1) female athlete (Refer to **D.3**).

B.3. Type of Allocation of Quota Places:

The quota place(s) is/are allocated to the NOC by discipline.

C. Athlete Eligibility

All athletes participating in the YOG must respect and comply with the provisions of the Olympic Charter currently in force. Only those athletes who respect and comply with the Olympic Charter, the World Anti-Doping Code and the Olympic Movement Code on the Prevention of the Manipulation of Competitions, including the conditions of participation established by the IOC, as well as with the rules of the International Biathlon Union (IBU), may participate in the YOG.

C.1. AGE REQUIREMENTS:

To be eligible to participate in the Winter Youth Olympic Games Gangwon 2024, athletes must have been born between 1 January 2006 and 31 December 2007.

Men: 40 Women: 40	D.1.1 The 2022/23 IBU World Cup Nation Cup Score ranking per gender will be calculated from 1 November 2022 to 30 March 2023. The 2022/23 IBU World Cup Nation Cup Score ranking ranks NOCs through their best three (3) competitors who earn Nations Cup points in Individual and Sprint events in World Cup events in the 2022/23 season. The Relay and applicable Mixed Relay Nations Cup points will be added to those from the Individual and Sprint and the cumulative sum of these points scored in World Cup events in the 2022/23 season will become the respective NOC's ranking (IBU Events and Competition Rules (15.8.3.2, 15.8.4.3)). Refer to IBU Events and Competition Rules (15.8.2.2) for the ranking points table.	
	D.1.2 The top 10 ranked NOCs in the respective gender's 2022/23 IBU World Cup Nation Cup Score as described in D.1.1 will be allocated four (4) quota places per NOC per gender.

Men: 60 Women: 60	D.2.1	The 2022/23 IBU Junior Cup Nation Cup Score ranking is formed by adding the points based on the IBU Events and Competition Rules (15.8.2.2) of each NOC at the following events: 1) Points earned by the top two (2) ranked athletes per NOC in the Individual and Sprint events at the Youth Junior World Championships (YJWCH) which includes both the Youth and Junior events.
		Points earned by the top two (2) ranked athletes per NOC in the Junior Open European Championships (JOECH).

HOST COUNTRY PLACES

The Host Country is allocated a quota of six (6) athletes of three (3) men and three (3) women, if it does not qualify through **D.1**. These quotas need to be confirmed by **2 April 2023** to IBU. The selection of athletes is at the discretion of the Host NOC while respecting the eligibility criteria as detailed in **C. Athlete Eligibility**.

The Host Country is entitled to enter one (1) team in the Mixed Relay event composed of two (2) men and two (2) women athletes and one (1) team in the Single Mixed Relay event composed of one (1) male and one (1) female athlete if the Host Country acquires sufficient quotas to form a team.

E. Confirmation Process for Quota Places

Following each qualification event, the IBU will publish the 2022/23 IBU World Cup Nation Cup Score and 2022/23 IBU Junior Cup Nation Cup Score on its website (www.biathlonworld.com).

IBU shall inform the NOCs that earn quota places through **D.1** and **D.2** within two (2) days after the publication of the final 2022/23 IBU World Cup Nation Cup Score and final 2022/23 IBU Junior Cup Nation Cup Score immediately after the last event of the season. The NOCs will then have two (2) weeks to confirm if they wish to use these quota places to IBU and Gangwon 2024 Sport Entries, as detailed in **G. Qualification Timeline**.

F. Reallocation of Unused Quota Places

REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUALIFICATION PLACES

If an allocated quota place is not confirmed by the NOC by the confirmation of the quota place deadline or is declined by the NOC, the quota place will be reallocated to the next best ranked NOC not yet qualified from respective gender's 2022/23 Junior Cup Nation Cup Score. NOCs that are reallocated quotas can only receive a maximum of one (1) quota per gender.

REALLOCATION OF UNUSED HOST COUNTRY PLACE

If the Host Country qualifies through **D.1** or **D.2** or if it declines all of its Host Country quota places, then the next ranked NOC, not yet qualified according to **D.1** or **D.2** in the respective gender's 2022/23 IBU Junior Cup Nation Cup Score, will be allocated three (3) quota places.

If the Host Country returns some of its host country places, these returned quota places will be reallocated according to **F. Reallocation of Unused Qualification Places** section.
